Collaborative Working

- Document Manager– manage documents and files and make them available for download e.g. metadata documents, protocols, reports, excel files etc. - [Links to Data Centres](#)
- Wiki - Based on the Hawaiian term wiki, meaning "quick" or "fast". A Wiki allows users to add and edit content online and is especially suited for collaborative writing.
- Bibliography - allows users to share author, book/article title, publisher/journal , published date and description. e.g. NEU bibliography or bibliography by Component
- Photo Gallery – upload images through browser

- Forums - NEU general forum, component forum – informal sharing of information, problem solving online.
