Logging on – individual unique username and password

Collaborative Working

- <u>Document Manager</u>

 manage documents and files and make them available for download e.g. metadata documents, protocols, reports, excel files etc. <u>Links to Data Centres</u>
- Wiki Based on the Hawaiian term wiki, meaning "quick" or "fast". A Wiki allows users to add and edit content online and is especially suited for collaborative writing.
- <u>Bibliography</u> allows users to share author, book/article title, publisher/journal, published date and description. e.g. NEU bibliography or bibliography by Component
- Photo Gallery upload images through browser

- <u>Forums</u> NEU general forum, component forum informal sharing of information, problem solving online.
 - e.g. Young Scientist Forum
- Managed Mailing Lists mass mailing to all NEU members or component mailing lists
- <u>Calendar</u> key events, meetings, deadlines
- Live chat, Skype?
